Internal Directive No. 1/2016

"Specification of publishing and research duties of professors, extraordinary professors, associate professors, and assistant professors at the University of Economics in Bratislava" with reference to the § 75 article 4, 5, 7 and 8 of the Law No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education and on Changes and Supplements to Some Laws

a) Publishing Activities

Over the period of 2 calendar years a full professor must reach a score of no less than 240, an extraordinary professor no less than 220, an associate professor no less than 200, and an assistant professor must reach a score of no less than 150, while at least 50% of the minimum threshold score must consist of points obtained in categories A1, A2 and B combined, and no more than 50% of the minimum threshold score may be obtained in category C.

Internal Directive No. 1/2016 is complementary to the existing assistant professorship and full professorship promotion criteria at the University of Economics in Bratislava (Internal Directive No. 4/2014), with a broad continual support of qualification growth remaining the main priority.

For the purposes of the qualification growth under existing assistant professorship and full professorship promotion criteria at the University of Economics in Bratislava, the following remains in force:

- University textbooks are publications with the candidate's authorship of no less than 3 AS.*
- Course literature are publications with the candidate's authorship of no less than 3 AS.

• Monographs are publications with the candidate's authorship of no less than 3 AS.

*AS – Author Sheet, 20 standard pages (1,800 characters with spaces per page) or 36,000 characters with spaces.

b) Research Activities

Pursuant to the § 75 article 4 of the Law No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education and on Changes and Supplements to Some Laws a lecturer holding a full professorship linked to a study programme is responsible for carrying out research and education activities in said study programme. With their research, educational and organizational activities, the full professor contributes to the development of knowledge in said study programme and to elucidation of its relationship to other study programmes; the full professor is responsible or co-responsible for the quality and development of the study programme implemented at the university or a faculty. Among the duties of a full professor are also creation of trends and conceptual frameworks, research activities and dissemination of their results in journals and academic or professional events of international importance, research team management and organization of international academic events.

Pursuant to the § 75 article 4 of the Law No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education and on Changes and Supplements to Some Laws a lecturer holding an associate professorship linked to a study programme in cooperation with a holder of a full professor linked to said study programme contributes with their research, educational and organizational activities to the development of knowledge in said study programme. Among the duties of an associate professor are also research activities and dissemination of their results in journals and academic or professional events of international importance, research team management and organization of international academic events.

Within 2 calendar years full professors, extraordinary professors and associate professors are required to obtain no less than 8 points, and assistant professors are required to obtain less than 6 points from the following research activities:

^{**}If more than one EUBA employee is involved in preparation and submission of the project, the score shall be divided according to the authorship share of the individual EUBA employees.

Note: For the purposes of this specification only approved and funded VEGA and KEGA projects with an internal EUBA project number shall be considered.

This Internal Directive was negotiated and approved on the Rector's Advisory Board meeting on 24 February 2016.

This Internal Directive shall enter into force on 15 March 2016. Internal Directive No. 2/2013 of 23 March 2013 as amended by the Supplement No. 1 shall expire on the day of entry into force of this Internal Directive.
