OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS IN BRATISLAVA NUMBER 8/2019

Principles of awarding grants of the University of Economics in Bratislava to young teachers, researchers and doctoral students in daily form of study The Rector of the University of Economics in Bratislava issues this Appendix no. 2 to internal directive no 8/2019 "Principles of awarding grants of the University of Economics in Bratislava to young teachers, to researchers and doctoral students in full-time study" from 8/28/2019 as amended of amendment no. 1 of 7 October 2020.

Article 1 point 2, which reads:

A young researcher may apply for a grant if, on the date of submission of the application, has not reached the age of 30. In the case of a collective of solvers, not even one member may be present at the time of submission applications to exceed the age of 30. The investigative team can have a maximum of five members and at least three members. At least one of the project solvers must be from another faculty or of the EU research workplace in Bratislava as the head of the research project (responsible solver).

changes to:

A young researcher can apply for a grant, which is understood as a person who at the time of submitting the application, she has not reached the age of 35 or 7 years have not passed since acquiring it of the title "PhD." (the period during which the person drew is not included in the 7-year period maternity or parental leave). In the case of a collective of solvers, not one member of exceed this limit at the time of application. The solving team can be maximum five-member and at least three-member. At least one of the project solvers must be from another faculty or the EU research workplace in Bratislava as the head of the research project (responsible solver).

In Article 3, point 3, letter e) confirmation of completion of the submitted Form is deleted project in the database of EU projects in Bratislava.

In Article 10, new points 2 and 3 are inserted after point 1, which read:

- 2. Control and allocation of points for publication outputs according to Appendix no. 4 will be carried out by the Department for science and doctoral studies based on submitted reports. Minimum number of points for publication activity is set at 10. For publication outputs in Web of databases Science or SCOPUS, which are also included in the list of ABDC journals (Australian Business Deans Council) or EUBA Star Journal List, the number assigned double points.
- 3. Based on the assessment of the final reports of the projects, the projects are awarded overall project evaluation as follows:

80 points and more - excellent level of project solution

50-79 points - very good level of project solution

49 points and less - insufficient level of project solution.

The numbering of other points in Article 3 is shifted.

This amendment no. 1 becomes valid and effective on the day of signature.
