PEER SUPPORT	The ESN buddies will contact the Incoming Students and in order to help them upon their arrival (way from the airport, etc.), how to get accostumed to living in Bratislava and to the student life.
ISIC	For students under 26, applicable for discounts at and outside the University. The ISIC card provides: • access to restricted areas (University buildings), • FAX Copy, Ticket Portal, and University Library access, • cheaper tickets for bus, tram transportation and for traveling, • discounts when visiting cultural institutions (such as museums and galleries).
University student card	Usually for those that can not get the ISIC-card. Only applies inside the University.
VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT	Non-EU citizens need a residence permit. The requirements may differ according to student's nationalities. Please turn to the Slovak embassies in your home countries.
HEALTH INSURANCE	Students from EU/EEA/Switzerland are entitled to health care and must present EHIC-card . Other students coming within a programme arising from an international treaty shall submit necessary documents certifying his/her study at a higher education institution in the Slovak Republic. Other than those aforementioned options students can take private insurance.
Accommodation	Limited number of dorm rooms are available in a private student residence "Incheba". Prices of rooms differ from 195 € to 380 € a month. More information can be found online at https://www.studentresidence.sk/en/. The International Mobility Department do not assist with finding a private accommodation.
